For the issues of **CoRe** in 2017, we welcome submissions of **articles**, **case notes** and **country reports** on, but not limited to, the following topics:

- Major ongoing antitrust matters (eg Google, Gazprom) and procedural trends (commitment cases with behavioral/structural remedies, settlement cases);
- EU and national antitrust enforcement in network industries;
- Consultation of procedural and jurisdictional aspects of EU merger control;
- Tax ruling investigations;
- Digital Single Market Strategy and competition rules (e-commerce regulation and sector inquiry, Electronic Communications Code, big data and antitrust, broadband rollout, roaming tariffs, net neutrality etc);
- Directive 2014/104/EU on antitrust damages actions.

All contributions will be subject to double blind peer-review before acceptance for publication and are required to conform to the author guidelines available at: www.lexxion.eu/core/author-guidelines
