This analysis of Israel's unwritten and basically flexible constitution traces the Zionist and British traditions which together have provided the fundamental notions of the Israeli system of parliamentary government; it is particularly concerned with the legal and conventional rules which determine the election of the Knesset, Israel's Parliament, and the Knesset's own rules of procedure.
