

Pioneers of Ethnomusicology by Mervyn McLean

Written for teachers and students of ethnomusicology, this book is the author's contribution to debate on current issues and trends in the discipline. Biographies of 98 pioneers of ethnomusicology occupy the central portion of the book. Flanking the biographies are comprehensive sections on the history of ethnomusicology, and discussion of conceptual and other issues arising from the work of the pioneers. Also included are intellectual ancestry charts, and an extensive chronology of events relevant to ethnomusicology. The book is generously illustrated with over 100 photographs of individuals, contributed in many cases by families of the pioneers or by institutions where they worked.

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
