ASLM PROGRAMS

Controversies in Law & Medicine: 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., Wednesday, Oct. 12, 1977.

An all-day workshop conference examining current controversies in law and medicine. Topics under consideration for this year's conference include: Issues of Informed Consent, Do Not Resuscitate Orders, Should Health System Agencies be Abolished?, Should Patient Access to Medical Records Statutes be Revoked or Expanded?, and Should Safety and Efficacy be Requirements for the Marketing of Drugs. The completed program will be announced in the Summer, 1977 issue of *Medicolegal News*. The morning session will feature two presentations from persons with opposing viewpoints on each of these critical topics. In the afternoon, there will be three concurrent workshops, one on each of the topics. These will be followed by a brief report from each workshop to the entire group which will close the session.

The program will be co-sponsored by ASLM and the Boston University Center for Law and Health Sciences, with Dr. Elliot L. Sagall and Professor George J. Annas acting as co-chairmen of the conference.

Registration fees for the all-day conference have been set at \$30.00 for non-ASLM members, \$25.00 for ASLM members and \$5.00 for students.

National Conference on Stress, Strain, Heart Disease and the Law — Friday and Saturday, January 27, and 28, 1978, at the Copley Plaza Hotel, Boston, Massachusetts.

To be presented in conjunction with the American Heart Association and the Massachusetts Affiliate, this program will feature talks by nationally prominent speakers and workshops on the medicolegal and insurance impact, applications and implementation of the recently released report of the American Heart Association's Committee on Stress, Strain and Heart Disease (See this issue *Medicolegal News*, pages 5 to 75 for complete text.) It is planned that subject matter include the extent of the problem, significant new developments since the last 1962 AHA Committee Report, the medical and legal evaluation of the relationship between stress and heart disease, workers' compensation and heart disease, cause-and-effect relationships involving stress and heart disease, disability evaluation of the cardiac patient, and other aspects of the interrelationship of heart disease and the law.
