Divided into numerous short sections it is easy to read and is perhaps the best all-round introduction to the problems. Fr Henry St John, O.P., has translated the book and added a long introduction specially for English readers. Fr Leeming's book provides an indispensable guide to the concrete situation, and to Catholic judgment on it. He gives a detailed history of the gradual coming together of Protestants, and of some Orthodox with them, and of the importance of this for the Catholic Church.
