**Irving L. Webber**, University of Florida sociology professor, is now teaching at the Universidad del Valle in Cali, Colombia, under a University of Florida program supported by a Rockefeller grant.

There will be several Latin Americans in residence at the University of Wisconsin, Madison, for the current academic year. **Nora Thielen**, of the University of Rio Grande do Sul, Brazil, taught Portuguese during the 1966

summer session. **Rosario Castellanos**, of the National University of Mexico, and **Germán Arciniegas** are teaching Spanish American Civilization, Dr. Castellanos the first semester and Dr. Arciniegas the second. **Jorge de Sena**, of Araquara, São Paulo, Brazil, will teach during both sessions. His specialty is the Brazilian novel. **Orlando Fals Borda** was associated with the Land Tenure Center during the months of April, May, and the summer session of 1966. **John Strasma**, of the Land Tenure Center, is teaching economics at the Instituto de Economía in Santiago. His work began in March 1966 and will continue through the entire year.

**H. Ernest Lewald** has assumed the direction of Latin American studies at the University of Tennessee. He was formerly with the Department of Modern Languages, Carleton College in Northfield, Minnesota.

**Martin C. Needler**, formerly professor of political science at the University of Michigan, has become director of the Division of Latin American Studies of the University of New Mexico.

## LIBRARIES AND ARCHIVES

*Aid to University Libraries in Latin America*—Programs for the improvement of university libraries in Latin America are continuing with support from AID, the Ford and Rockefeller Foundations, and with the technical assistance of several U.S. librarians. Ford Foundation grants provide assistance and advisory services to the University of Chile and Catholic University in Santiago. The Rockefeller Foundation supports a library director from the United States for the Universidad del Valle in Cali, Colombia. Two librarians from the University of Minnesota staff are advising the University of Concepción, Chile, on its Library services. An AID contract with St. Louis University supports a U.S. librarian serving for a third year in the organization of library services for the Catholic University in Quito.

*Bibliographical Activities of INIA*—Projects in progress as the Instituto Nacional de Investigaciones Agrícolas in Mexico include the following: 1) *Catálogo colectivo de publicaciones periódicas existentes en bibliotecas de la República Mexicana*. Pablo Velásquez and Ramón Nadurille of Biblioteca INIA are preparing this compilation for publication in 1967. Relying on information solicited on 35,000 postcards from some 120 libraries, the bibliography will list complete volumes and the numbers held of the incomplete ones for each of the titles registered in the cooperating libraries. 2) *Las obras de consulta en español; una lista preliminar* will be developed from some 5,000 file cards obtained primarily from secondary sources. It is to be published in 1967. 3) *Bibliografía agrícola y agraria de México, 1945–1966*. This is compiled as are the two above, by Velásquez and Nadurille. These two authors will also prepare the Directorio Agronómico Nacional, a bio-bibliographical directory of persons conducting agricultural research in Mexico.
