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THE PYRAMID AND THE CROWN: THE EGYPTIAN BEER INDUSTRY FROM 1897 TO 1963—CORRIGENDUM

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There was a transcription error in the first paragraph of page 150 in the original article, which is corrected here.¹ We regret this error and any problems it may have caused.

For example, at al-Ahram Brewery in 1957, the highest paid non-Egyptian employee made over eighty Egyptian pounds more than the highest paid Egyptian employee. The forty-one Egyptians combined earned 2,126 Egyptian pounds in salaries, bonuses, and incentives, while the eight non-Egyptian employees earned 1,042 Egyptian pounds.
