Since Deng Xiaoping set the People's Republic of China on the road to economic reform in 1978, the country has made remarkable economic progress. The government's final economic figures for 1992 demonstrate the reform's effectiveness.

The National Economic Atlas of China is the most comprehensive and detailed picture of this remarkable achievement ever compiled. Over 20 ministries, under the leadership of the State Planning Commission, provided data for the Atlas at a remarkable level of detail and specificity. Some of China's most important statistical records were drawn upon, such as the Industrial Census of 1985 and the Third and Fourth Population Censuses of 1982 and 1990, the largest and most comprehensive investigations ever conducted at the national level. Reference was also made to a large number of restricted publications, and several ministries carried out special surveys to provide data for the *Atlas* project. The

computer database produced exceeds 100 million bytes.

This remarkable collection of data has been presented in the *Atlas* through both maps and text. The 265 maps are divided into ten groups, covering geographical and administrative background; resources; population; general economy; agriculture; industry; communications; building, urban construction, and environmental protection; commerce, foreign trade, tourism and finance; education, scientific research, culture, sports and health; as well as the regional comprehensive economy of each of China's provinces and major cities.

This is one of the finest examples of a National Atlas ever produced, and is a major contribution to our understanding of one of the most remarkable economic and social changes of our times.

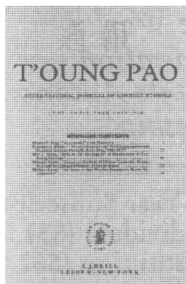
