Cross and Crown is concerned with those truths which alone can give meaning and value to all of our living—the nature and the development of our inner spiritual life. Each issue (128 pages) contains eight to ten articles which reveal the wealth and beauty of the spiritual teachings of the theology of St Thomas Aquinas, the official theologian of the Church.

A survey of the indexes of *Cross and Crown* reveals its varied scope in subject matter and contributors. Eminent authorities in spiritual theology have explained in plain, striking phrases what the life of God in man really is. Among these have been such Dominicans as Garrigou-Lagrange, Walter Farrell, Gerald Vann, and Jordon Aumann. Topflight Jesuit theologians such as De Letter and Klaas are among the contributors. Other well-known names in the roster are Hilda Graef, Dorothy Dohen, and Sister Julian Baird.

Each issue of *Cross and Crown* presents reviews of the newest spiritual books, both scientific and popular. A department called 'Current Trends' provides a compact survey of new developments in every aspect of the inner life.
