THE HAGUE PRIZE FOR INTERNATIONAL LAW

On the 18th of September 2002 The Hague Prize for International Law was launched by The Hague Prize Foundation, The Hague, The Netherlands.

The prize will be awarded at least every four years to individual(s) and/or organizations who have made – through publications or achievements in the practice of law – a special contribution to the development of public international law, private international law or to the advancement of the rule of law in the world. The prize consists of a special medal and a monetary award of € 50,000.00, which will be given for the first time in the Spring of 2004 to the recipient during a special award ceremony at the Peace Palace in The Hague, The Netherlands.

The Board of The Hague Prize Foundation hereby kindly invites anyone to nominate candidates (with a preference for individuals), who deserve such recognition.
