Any classical scholar is eligible for membership. The subscription of a member resident in Cambridge is £2.10 annually, except that the subscription of a resident research student is £1.25. The subscription of a member resident elsewhere is £1.25 annually. Members receive notices of all meetings of the Society and copies of its publications.

Any library may subscribe to the Society and receive copies of its publications. The subscription for libraries is £2.10 per annum.

The Society is responsible for two series of publications.

*Proceedings of the Cambridge Philological Society*, containing papers read to the Society and other articles by members, appears annually. Contributions intended for the Proceedings should be addressed to Dr J. Diggle, Queens' College, Cambridge.

*Supplements to the Proceedings*, consisting of monographs, are an occasional series appearing less frequently and at irregular intervals. This series is designed to accommodate works of intermediate size, i.e. of about 100 pages.
