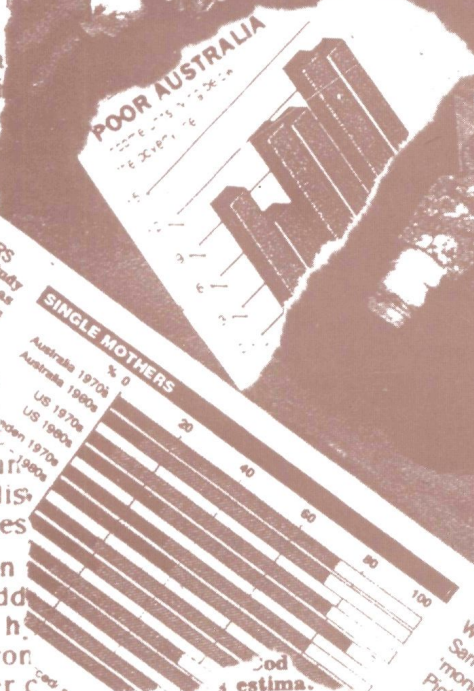

Child poverty still a problem
