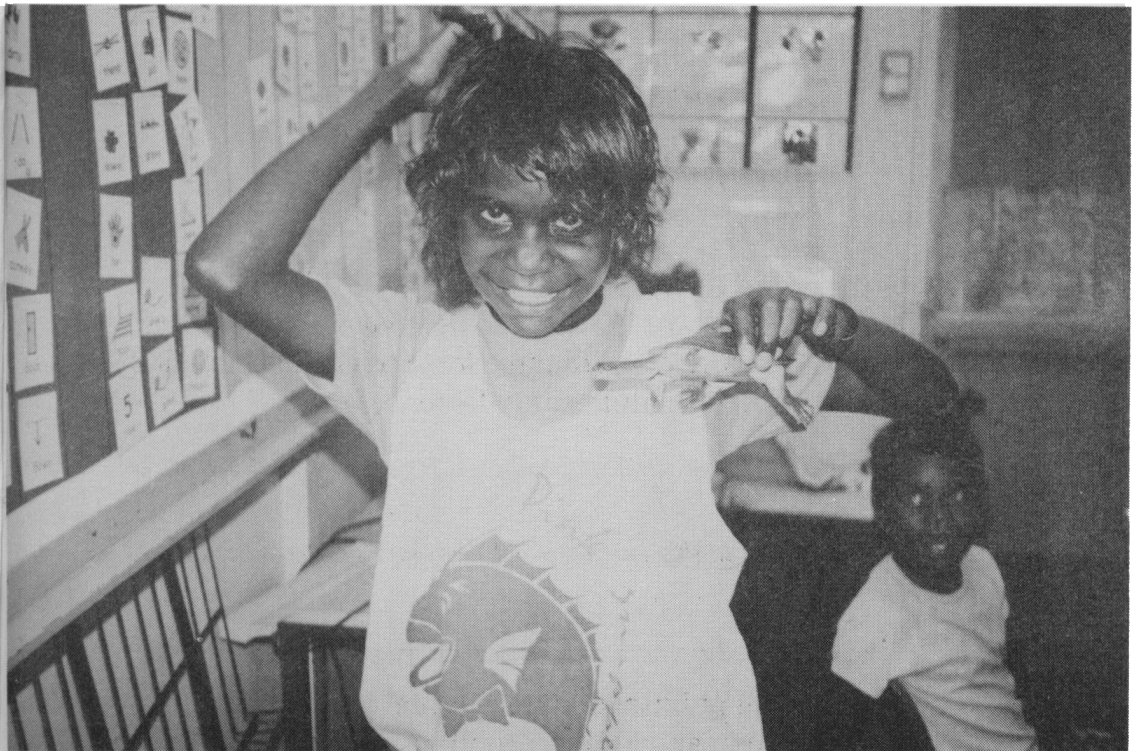


THE ABORIGINAL CHILD AT SCHOOL
