- BIBLE DE JÉRUSALEM: (Cerf); more than a dozen fascicules have recently been reprinted in a revised edition; also a bound New Testament, 16mo, rather expensive at 1200 frs, in spite of its excellent print and format.
- THE ACTS OF THE APOSTLES: Stonyhurst Scripture manuals (Longmans; 10s.); a text book for schools, with introduction and commentary by Fr Martindale, s.J.
- BIBLICAL SUBJECT INDEX: edited by W. J. Kiefer (Newman; \$4.50); a sketchy concordance for a busy preacher.
- PROBLEMS IN THE LITURGY: by G. Montague (Browne and Nolan; 40s.); a book of questions and answers.
- THE NEW GUEST-ROOM BOOK: (Sheed and Ward; 18s.); a very miscellaneous anthology compiled by F. J. Sheed.
- THOUGHTS IN SOLITUDE (Burns and Oates; IOS. 6d.); further meditations by Thomas Merton.
- DIVINE FRIENDSHIP: by J. Wilms, O.P. (Blackfriars; 12s.); an accurate but somewhat dry exposition of St Thomas' teaching on charity.
- SIMON CALLED PETER: by Mary Simeon, S.H.C.J. (Browne and Nolan; 125. 6d.); simple meditations on what the gospels have to say about St Peter, handsomely illustrated with woodcuts.
- HEAVEN ON EARTH (Newman; \$2.50); the spiritual teaching of Clare Fey, foundress of the Sisters of the Poor Child Jesus.
- MEET SAINT TERESA: by J. P. Kelly (Pustet; \$3.95. Herder; 32s.); a popular picture, daubed in the brassy colours of amateur American journalese.
- LITANY AT NAZARETH: by J. J. McNally (Herder; 24s.); being fortynine homilies preached on the Litany of Loreto.
- MEDITATIONS IN LENT: by Sebastian Bullough, O.P. (Blackfriars; 25.); a small booklet of seven meditations on the desert wanderings of Israel, which appeared last year during Lent in the *Tablet*.
- THE NEW LITURGY OF HOLY WEEK: This is a Holy Week supplement, in about 150 pages, to the St Andrew Daily Missal produced by Dom G. Lefebvre, O.S.B., of St André, Belgium. It is quite complete in itself, containing the ordinary of the Mass as well as the proper for Holy Week. We regret having mislaid the notice of its price.
