

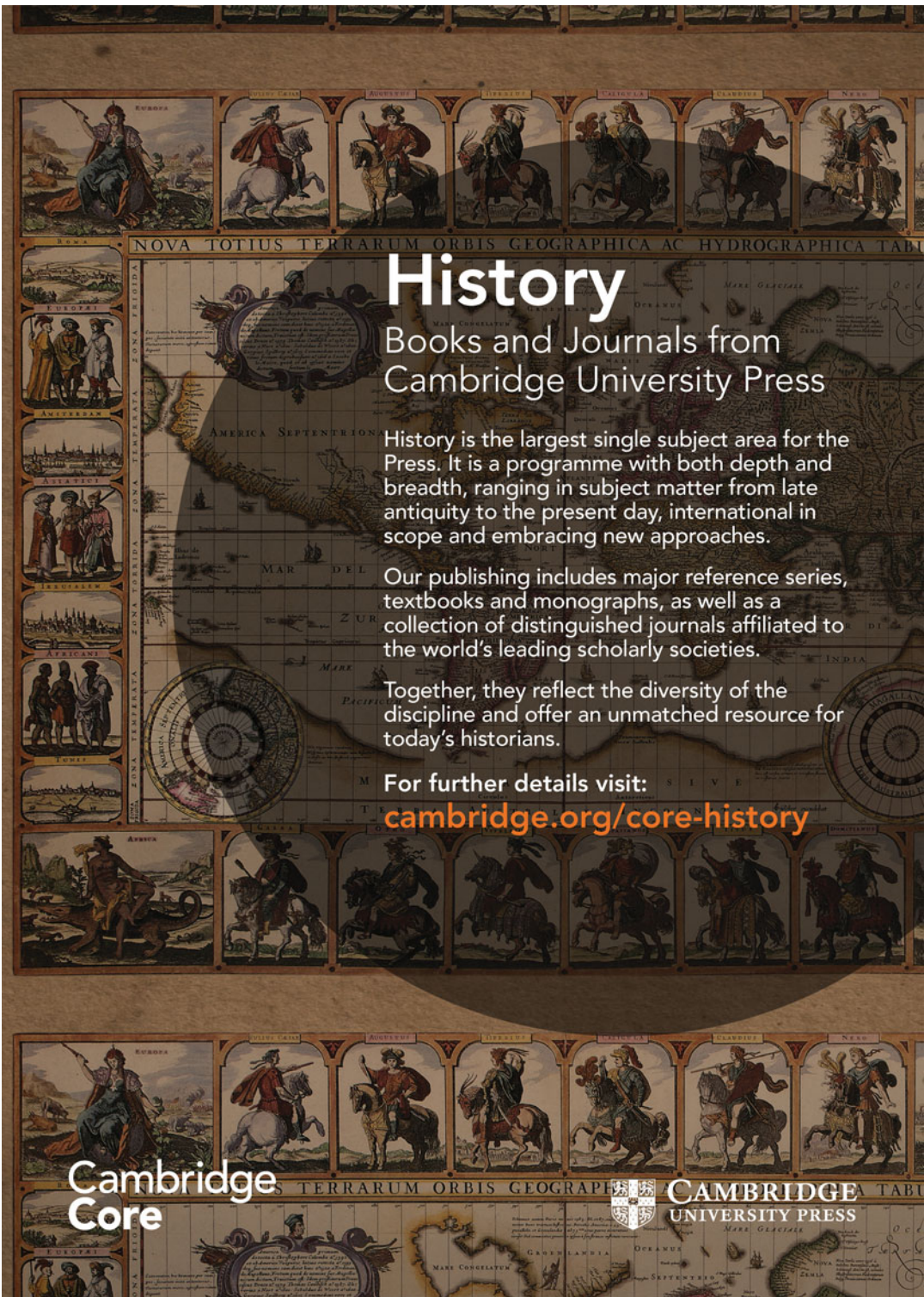
Cover Art: Illustration showing T. G. Masaryk with Legionnaires from all the fronts, "To your health, Father Masaryk!"
