The following Opinion has been published recently by the International Commission on Zoological Nomenclature, c/o British Museum (Natural History), Cromwell Road, London SW7 5BD, UK.

Opinion no. 1371 (*Bulletin of Zoological Nomenclature* 43 (1), p. 19, 9 April 1986).

Pachycephalosaurus Brown & Schlaikjer, 1943 and *Troodon wyomingensis* Gilmore, 1931 (Reptilia, Dinosauria): conserved.

The International Commission on Zoological Nomenclature gave six months' notice on 9 April 1986 of the possible use of its plenary powers in the following cases.

Case no. 2505 (*Bulletin of Zoological Nomenclature* 43 (1), 9 April 1986).

Tylocidaris Pomel, 1883 (Echinoidea, Cidaroidea): proposed designation of *Cidaris clavigera* Mantell, 1822 as type species.

Case no. 2479 (*Bulletin of Zoological Nomenclature* 43 (1), 9 April 1986).

Ammonites perarmatus J. Sowerby, 1822 (Cephalopoda, Ammonoidea): proposed exemption from the Principle of Homonymy.

Case no. 637 (*Bulletin of Zoological Nomenclature* 43 (1), 9 April 1986).

Type species of the genus *Calymene* Brongniart (Trilobita) in Brongniart & Desmarest, 1822 and proposed suppression of the name *tuberculatus* Brünnich, 1781.
